

Dear Queen's families

Further to the Co-Headteachers' message at the end of last term, we are now able to give more details of the wraparound care we aim to offer in the Autumn term.

Breakfast club

Breakfast club will be available each day, starting on **Monday 7th September**, from 7.45 until the start of school. The club will take place in the hall, with the children seated in their year group 'bubbles' at widely-spaced tables across both sides of the hall. To enable us to ensure we are within safe capacity, and that tables are arranged appropriately for the children attending each day, spaces must be booked, and confirmed by the office via e-mail, no later than 3pm on the previous school day (by noon on Friday 4th for the first day, please). **Walk-ins cannot be permitted.**

Tinies Kew Kids

Tinies have been in contact with all Queen's families registered with them to ask for indications of interest in their after-school care. Unfortunately, the responses received suggested that fewer than a dozen children would be attending, which is not sufficient to make the provision viable at the start of term. The staff have been trained in Covid protocols and are ready to return to work, but without sufficient numbers the provision cannot be offered.

A further survey of interest was sent out at the end of last week, and if numbers are sufficient the aim is to start offering the provision from **Monday 28th September**. If you wish to make use of this provision **it is essential that you respond** to the survey of interest – or for families not previously registered with Tinies, that you contact them to request the provision – **by Friday 4th September**. If the responses show sufficient interest, it may be possible to bring forward the start of provision.

Extra-curricular clubs

After-school clubs will mainly operate on a single year-group basis, with changing and wet-weather activities for outdoor clubs in one of that year group's classrooms. We are still discussing with the club providers which clubs can be viable with a single year group. Some clubs may be offered on the basis that they will only run if sufficient numbers enrol.

Unfortunately, because the children will be using their classrooms to eat lunch, it will not be possible to offer lunchtime clubs this term.

We will publish a proposed schedule as soon as possible. We expect clubs to begin in the week of **28st September**, with four sessions before half-term and six after half term, finishing in the week beginning 7th December.
