- 2650 BCE** First step pyramid built
- 2550 BCE** Pyramids at Giza built
- 1336 BCE** Tutankhamen becomes pharaoh
- 1279 BCE** Ramses II becomes pharaoh
- 332 BCE** Alexander the Great conquers Egypt
- 196 BCE** Rosetta stone carved
- 30 BCE** Egypt becomes a Roman Province
- 1922 CE** Carter discovers Tutankhamen's tomb
