Lunchtime clubs

If your child is attending a lunchtime club, **please remind your child on the morning of the club that they need to go to the club that lunchtime.** We sometimes have children who forget to attend lunchtime clubs. We do our best to find the children when this happens.

Sign up and payment

Sign up will be via Parent mail from **Tuesday 17th March at 8pm and will close on Tuesday 31st March at midnight.** If you are not registered with Parent mail, please email clubs@queens.richmond.sch.uk as soon as possible in order to register. **Payment charges are minimised for the school if you use a debit card.** If you would like to pay by salary sacrifice vouchers you can do this but **you will still need to pay by your bank card** in the usual way to secure a place and we will refund your card when the vouchers come into school. Please do not make payment by childcare vouchers until your child's place is confirmed, as it is not legal for us to refund these vouchers.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Hockey and Gymnastic are booked and paid for directly to Kids Coaching Hive.
- Karate Tuesdays Lunch and after school registration and payment to be done through FSKA and Pee-Wee Karate.

Do not pay any other club providers direct.

By signing up for a club you are agreeing to pay for the club for the whole term irrespective of whether your child attends all sessions.

Any club which does not have sufficient children to make it viable will be cancelled, parents who have booked will be advised and refunded via Parentmail.

Some clubs are more popular than others and all have a maximum number of children that can participate, therefore we operate a waiting list for oversubscribed clubs so please email clubs@queens.richmond.sch.uk if you wish your child to be added to a club's waiting list.

Please do not approach the club direct if your child is on the waiting list, all queries **must** go through the school office.

Behaviour

At the Queen's school we have high expectations for behaviour during the school day and these expectations are the same for children attending extra-curricular clubs. If a child's behaviour is disruptive during a club, parents/carers will be informed. We remind all parents/carers that club leaders have the right to discontinue a child's attendance, if a child's behaviour does not improve. No refund will be paid in these circumstances.

Refunds

Please ensure your child is free to attend an after-school club! We **cannot refund** you if you have double booked your child in a club when they already have an out of school activity at the same time, or if your child decides they no longer wish to continue with a club because they have changed their mind and do not want to complete the whole term. Each club needs to fill a certain number of places for it to be financially viable and worthwhile us running. We therefore need to secure a certain number of places. Additionally, by taking a club place, this prevents the place being available to another child. **We will only give a refund in exceptional circumstances.**

Pick-up

Please note the time the club finishes. This is detailed for each club. The club provider will bring the children to the specified collection point. The gates to the secure side of the school will remain closed until the clubs have finished and the children are inside the school building. For safeguarding reasons parents do not need to come into school to collect children, please wait outside for your children.
