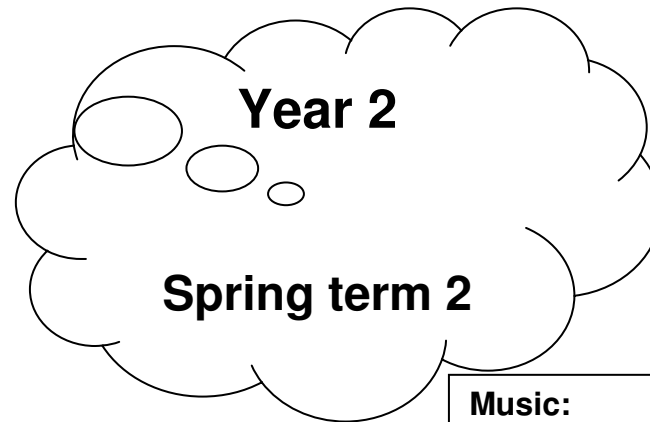
Great Fire of London

Instructions (2 weeks)

To be able to read, write and follow simple instructions

Traditional Tales (2 weeks)

Identifying features of traditional tales and retelling familiar traditional tales

Playscripts (2 weeks)

Read and explore playscripts

Collaboratively write playscripts based on puppet characters and perform plays to Y1

Music:

Explore feelings and emotions and relate them to different scenarios
