To develop our understanding of characteristic features of a society and explore their way of life and find out about the different ways the past is represented.

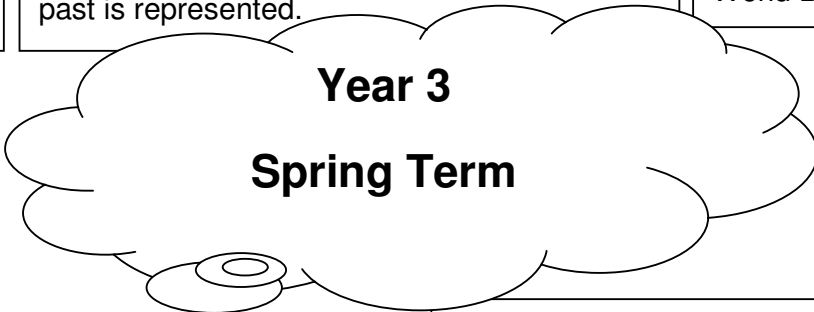
Literacy:
