Music: to create, combine and perform rhythmic and melodic material as part of a class performance of a song.

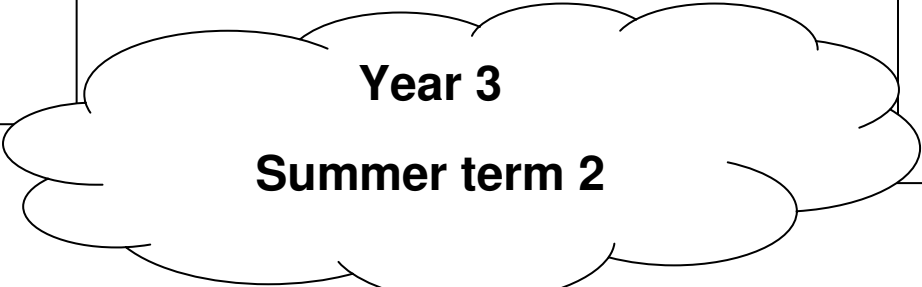
Recorders & Orchestra
